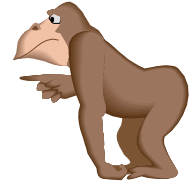


## GORILLA SUMMER SCHEDULE

Our days will vary due to the field trips.  
Below is a general schedule for a day at Noah's Ark.



7:00am-8:00am	Free play with all age groups
8:00am-9:30am	Breakfast time and recreation in Miller Hall or outside
9:30am-9:45am	Group discussion time
9:45am-11:15am	Center activities in Gorilla room
11:15am-11:30am	Clean up and prepare for lunch
11:30am-12:00pm	Lunch
12:00pm-12:30pm	Silent reading
12:30pm-2:00pm	Outside recreation time
2:00pm-3:00pm	Center activities in Gorilla room
3:00pm-3:30pm	Snack time
3:30pm-4:00pm	Chore time
4:00pm-5:30pm	Outdoor or indoor Recreation time
5:30pm-6:00pm	Quiet time



**Center time** will be a time of activity choice. The choices will vary. Some examples are; coloring, drawing, board games, learning activities, pretend play, reading, journal writing and toy play.

**Items from home:** Please do not bring items from home, unless it is a book for silent reading. Noah's Ark will provide plenty of activities for the children to do during the day. Noah's Ark will not be responsible for broken or lost items.

**Recreation** is outdoor time or gym time. There will be times when the children walk to Howard school or Grace Abbott Park to play on the playground equipment.
