




LOAVES AND FISHES

FOOD MINISTRY

Trinity has faithfully helped feed people of our community for many years in many ways. The second Saturday of each month many from our church along with some from First Presbyterian church distribute 525 boxes of shelf staples, 525 boxes of fresh produce, and 525 loaves of bread. Some months there is also extra fresh produce to give out. Along with this, we have a little free drive by pantry box outside door 1 which is faithfully filled by many from our church. And even more, we provide snacks for students at Howard School. Then add to this that at Christmas time, Mathetes Bible study fills about a dozen bags of food for families from Howard who may need some extra food over the holiday. And there is even more, funeral lunches are provided for those who ask for it after the service. Wednesday night meals are open to anyone. This is a great way to fellowship with others. On top of this, we have had a hugely successful garden this summer which has been supported by church members and McCain foods. Anyone from the community can harvest produce and it has been well used. Let's add another way we help feed others. Four times a year our Mission Committee prepares and serves a Sunday night meal at the Salvation Army and once a month a couple of people simply help serve a week night meal. Crossroads Mission is also helped at times by our church. When there are extra boxes left from Loaves and Fishes, Crossroads faithfully comes to pick them up when called. Thank you and blessings to all who support these many ministries of Trinity. Keep up your gracious giving of food through Trinity.
