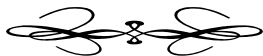
Maybe you think that you are not equipped to help with children or Youth. for one thing remember that you: "can do all this through Him who gives me strength."

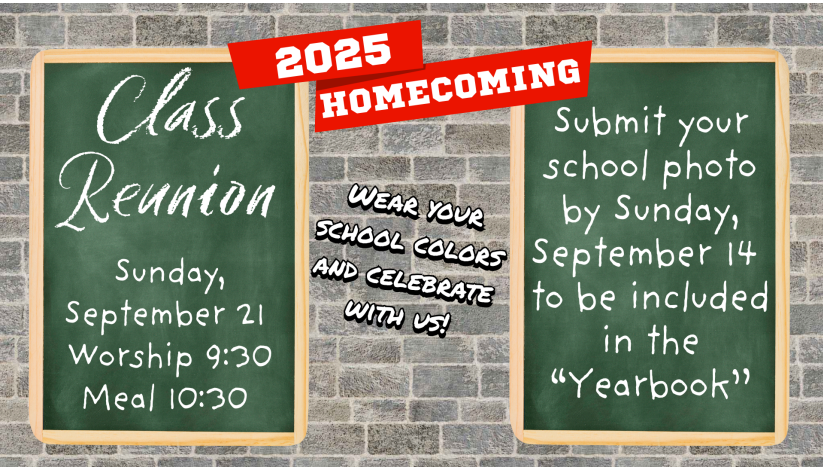
Loaves & Fishes Food Distribution . . .
