We currently have 46 pledges for a total of \$89,445.

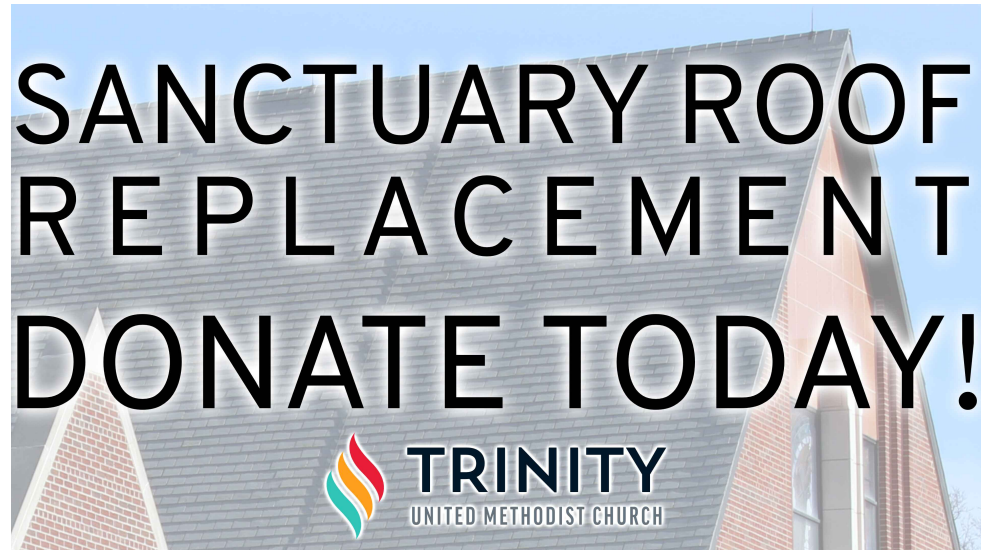
Pledges currently paid: \$45,206.38
